NASHUA SCHOOL DISTRICT Requirements for Enrollment Grades 12 IMMUNIZATION LAW RSA 161

Children must have proof of all NH State required immunizations, documentation of immunity, or valid exemptions, in order to be enrolled in any New Hampshire school according to NH State Law RSA 161

All immunizations must meet minimum age and interveduirements for each vaccine. A 4-day grace period is allowed; however, live attenuated vaccines (MMR, Varicella, or nasal influenza vaccine) that are not administered on the same day, must be administered at least 28 days apart.

DTaP/DTP: 3-doseswith the last one given after age 4

Tdap 1 dose for entry into ^t7 grade.

Polio: 34 doseswith the last one given after age 4

Hepatitis B 3 doses.

MMR: 2 doses.

Varicella: 2 doses.

A child may be "conditionally" enrolled when the parent or guardian provides:

1. Documentation of at least one dose fearch required vaccine; AND
