

SITE SELECTION

The Board of Education, in accordance with the powers vested through state statutes (RSA 199:2), has the authority to select school sites. To assist with this process, the Finance & Operations Committee of the Board shall have the responsibility to review sites and to make a recommendation to the Board.

In assessing school sites, the Board and the Finance & Operations Committee will review demographic data, standards, and other relevant criteria and attempt to make decisions based on short-term and long-range needs. Information may be solicited from a variety of persons and sources including, but not limited to, the Superintendent of Schools and the administrative staff, architects and engineers, consultants, and personnel from the affected City Department.
