

PARENTAL OBJECTIONS TO SPECIFIC COURSE MATERIAL provide parents and legal guardians with the opportunity to object to specific curriculum course material used for instructional purposes in a particular subject area. This notification and request shall be in writing.

The building principal, acting on behalf of the District, and the parent must mutually agree to the alternative instruction. The alternative instruction agreed upon must meet State minimum standards. The cost associated with the alternative instruction shall be borne by the parent/guardian. No alternative instruction shall create an undue burden for a teacher in meeting the needs of his or her class.

The parent/guardian is responsible for providing appropriate documentation that alternative instruction, has been completed as agreed.

If a principal, acting on another acceptable alternative, the parent's decision will be final.
