EARNING OF CREDIT

Students can earn course credit by demonstrating understanding of the required course competencies. Course competencies include required content, concepts, and skills. The school district shall provide a framework for grading and assessments based on course competencies, and the teacher shall ensure that students understand and work towards those course competencies.

Credit will be awarded upon satisfactory demonstration of understanding of the required course competencies as outlined in Policy ILBAA-R, <u>Competency Assessment Regulation and Procedures</u>.
